Admission Coordinator, Dr. Rakesh Jain welcomed the members and spelt out the agenda of the meeting.

Agenda No.1: To layout the admission process for UG and PG for the Academic Year 2020-21.

Admission Coordinator, Dr. Rakesh Jain informed that in view of COVID-19 SOP it will not be possible to hold entrance test as the government has already cancelled semester end examinations of second and fourth semesters of UG programs and second semester of PG programs. Dr. Ram Krishna proposed to prepare the merit list for admissions in UG programs

on the basis of marks received in intermediate/12th standard. Dr. Aparna Singh suggested to add 50% marks of high school/10th standard to prepare the merit list. It was also suggested that final dates for counselling for admissions and other formalities maybe decided in compliance with the government orders and COVID-19 SOPs to maintain social distancing.

Agenda No.2: To review the admission criteria to be followed in compliance with college admission rules and reservation rules of state government.

Admission Coordinator, Dr. Rakesh Jain enumerated the eligibility criteria for admissions in various programs in compliance with affiliating university rules and state government orders pertaining to reservations for various categories.

5.	BBA / BBA(MS)	50% marks in Intermediate / 12 th standard
6.	BCA	50% marks in Intermediate / 12 th standard
7.	B.Voc. (SD&eG)	50% marks in Intermediate / 12 th standard
8.	B.Voc. (B&F)	50% marks in Intermediate / 12 th standard
9.	All PG Programs	50% marks in Graduation

Dr. Rakesh Jain explained that 5% marks will be relaxed for reserved categories for professional programs whereas in B.A. and B.Com. 50% seats are reserved for SC/ST and OBC.

Agenda No. 3: To inform about the new program M.A. (English) being launched.

Admission Coordinator, Dr. Rakesh Jain informed that process for starting a new P.G. program (M.A.-English) under rules for Autonomous Colleges 2018 has been completed. We plan to launch the program in the forthcoming academic year i.e. 2020-21. The program will have sixty (60) seats under self-financing mode. Members welcomed the information.
